RESOLUTION

Regarding County Youth Leadership Alliance Plans for Fiscal Year 2023

June 21, 2022

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) was awarded funding to supplement its Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SAPT-BG) from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA); and

WHEREAS, the DMHAS and GCADA seek to implement a statewide youth leadership program that will include substance use prevention outreach, education and training services for youth that will utilize supplemental SAPT-BG funding; and

WHEREAS, GCADA warrants and represents that it shall acquire and implement the requisite education and training services through each of the twenty-one (21) County Alliance Coordinators and their respective Municipal Alliances created pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:2BB-7; and

WHEREAS, the GCADA warrants and represents that the County Alliance Coordinators and their Municipal Alliances shall be required to coordinate the substance abuse prevention services with GCADA to maximize the utilization of the SAPT-BG services funded under the Memorandum Of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the GCADA in accordance with the Memorandum Of Agreement with DMHAS, it has received the County Youth Leadership Alliance Plans for Fiscal Year 2023 from:
